

## What is Provisional Camping at Broad Creek?

Provisional Camping is an opportunity for an individual Scout to experience a full week of summer camp without having to come with their Troop or parent/guardian.

## How does Provisional Camping Work?

Broad Creek's staff provides the Scoutmaster and additional leadership for all provisional Scouts in attendance. This covers both male and female Scouts, for all 5 weeks of summer camp.

## Is this the Same Camp Experience?

Scouts will work on merit badges, rank advancement, first year camper programs, Older-Scout programs, or any other activities offered during summer camp operation.

## What if a Scout Already Attended a Camp?

Provisional camping is also a chance for a Scout to experience a second week of camping... whether to finish merit badges, or just enjoy the fun and adventure of the outdoor program.

## What does my Camp Fee Cover?

- 7 Blocks for Merit Badges and Program each day
- Evening Program every night
- 3 Meals a day, lunch being a grab-and-go style
- Tent and Cot (wall canvas tents on wooden platform with metal frame)
- Latrines in campsites and shower house in center of camp
- Camp Trading Post available for souvenirs and needed supplies
- All Inclusive Camping Fee, no additional fees for Merit Badge or Program supplies.

## Camperships (Financial Assistance)

- Camperships are a discount up to 50% of the Early Bird rate
- They are only eligible to Scouts registered with the BAC
- They are approved monthly by a group of Council Volunteers

## Order of the Hemlocks

Already earned most Merit Badges offered at summer camp? Join our Older Scout Program and earn the Exploration Merit Badge while experiencing Black Powder Rifle, River Tubing, Rock Climbing, our ATV Instruction Course, overnight treks at our waterfront, and challenging hikes to the more remote parts of Broad Creek. All of this is part of our Scout Vs Wild style journey for Scouts aged 14+.

## Aquatics

Beyond the standard waterfront activities, Broad Creek offers Water Sports, Sailing, and Stand-Up Paddle-boarding on the 12 miles of deep water at the Susquehanna River. New for 2020 is our renovated swimming pool in the center of camp!



## Will my Scout be safe?

- Broad Creek has a certified Health Lodge staff available 24 hours a day
- Qualified and trained instructors (including National Camp School and First Aid Certifications)
- Provisional Scoutmasters are registered leaders in the Boy Scouts of America, which requires Youth Protection Training and a background check
